

Court Designation

- **Overview and USTA Guidelines:** Only members of Canyon Club are allowed to reserve courts. Members may not reserve courts for USTA league matches or practices unless the team is playing out of, and captained by members, of the club Canyon Club
- **Tennis Court 1 & Pickleball Court 5** are the teaching courts and are used by our teaching professionals. However, if you see that the courts are open, please feel free to hop on. Just know that if a Pro Coach shows up to conduct a lesson or clinic then you will need to give the court back until they are finished
- **The Hitting Wall on Pickleball Court 5** may be used to warm up or practicing hitting against when no one else is playing. However, if a Pro Coach or scheduled program needs the court then they will have priority and you will need to give the court back until they are finished
- **Tennis Court 2 | Pickleball Courts 1 & 2 and Tennis Court 3 | Pickleball Courts 3 & 4** are available for both tennis and pickleball.
 - When reserving tennis courts, please try to reserve courts 4 and 5 before courts 2 and 3 so that pickleball members might still be able to reserve courts as well
 - When reserving pickleball courts, please try and reserve courts 1 and 2 first so that tennis players can use court 3, and then be closer to courts 4 and 5 when needed
- **Tennis Courts 2-5 & Pickleball Courts 1-4** are reservable up to 14 days in advance.
- **Reserving Courts**
 - In order to hold a court, all members will be required to reserve their desired court time(s)
 - Members can reserve courts and see all availability through our online portal or by the app (Please visit our website or contact us for more info)
 - Members may reserve no more than two courts at the same time.
 - Maximum allotted time for reservations time is 2 hrs. Please try to keep reservations to 1½ hrs for single's play, and 2 hrs for doubles, play during the weekends/primetimes
 - A reserved court is deemed an open court after 10 minutes of tardiness by the players who made the court reservation
- **Guests Policies**
 - Members may invite guests to come play at the club. However, you may not invite the same guest player more than two times a month
 - You will be able to add a guest to a court reservation and then pay the 8-dollar guest fee once finished
 - *Members found to be taking advantage of the guest policies may forfeit all future court reservation privileges
 - If you have family coming into town and would like to see about more court time, please contact us for more information and options
- **Exceptions Regarding Court Usage:** The above rules are suspended during club sponsored tournaments and events

Court Polices

- Players are to wear appropriate clothing and tennis shoes. (Please wear shirts if courts are busy or asked to by another player) No swimsuits please

- Players are expected to conduct themselves in a sportsmanlike manner, which includes no loud shouting or inappropriate language; and no racket throwing or abuse of the courts, nets, wind screens or trash receptacles
- During lessons, clinics, and tournament play, parents and spectators wishing to view the activity are asked to use the benches and chairs outside the courts
- For safety and distraction reasons, only children who are playing tennis are allowed on the tennis courts
- No glass containers may be carried onto the court
- No smoking is permitted on or by the courts
- Please respect those following you on court by disposing of your used cups and other trash.

Ground Regulations

- Playing sports other than tennis and pickleball, such as soccer, is not permitted on the courts unless given express permission by PRO Sports
- Please do not allow your children to climb tennis court fences and bordering property fences; or play on hillsides adjacent to the tennis courts
